The <u>1st Bilateral Thoracic Surgery Congress</u> was organized in Lückendorf in 1979 by thoracic surgeons from the *German Democratic Republic* and *Hungary*, thanks to an agreement concerning scientific collaboration between those two countries that had been reached in 1977. Colleagues from Czechoslovakia also participated in that congress. The following two congresses were held in Hungary, first in Szombathely in 1980, and then in Siofok in 1981.

Czechoslovakia officially joined the congress in 1983, and in that year the **1st Trilateral Thoracic Surgery Congress** was organized in Prague. The 2nd and the 3rd Trilateral Meetings followed: in Johann-Georgenstadt in 1985 and in Szeged in 1987. In addition to the participants from the three founding countries, a total of 68 foreign guests also took part in the meeting in Szeged, arriving form Poland, Austria, The German Federal Republic, Italy, Sweden and the United Kingdom. The leading authorities of these Trilateral Symposia were Prof. Neef (Halle, Germany), Prof. Řehák (Prague, Czechoslovakia), Prof. Wechsler (Brno, Czechoslovakia), Prof. Keszler (Budapest, Hungary), Prof. Kulka (Budapest, Hungary), Prof. Kiss (Debrecen, Hungary) and many others.

The last of the Trilateral Symposia - the 7th - and the first after the collapse of the "Iron Curtain" - took place in Bad Schandau, Germany, in 1992 (organized by Dr. Baudrexl, Coswig; Prof. Barthel, Jena; Prof. Neef, Halle).

The subsequent meeting was organized as the <u>1st International Thoracic Surgery Congress</u> headed by Dr. Kecskés (President) in Szombathely, Hungary, in 1993.
