## Welcome Address

The Austrian Society of Surgical Oncology (ACO-ASSO) is honored to announce its 23rd Annual Meeting, which is organized together with the 11th International Thoracic Surgery Congress. For the first time in the history of these two organizations it is an interdisciplinary Central European meeting with the participation of Austria, the Czech Republic, Germany, Hungary, Poland, Slovakia and Switzerland.



The main topic of the congress is lung cancer, which is the most common

cause of death in cancer patients in Europe. In state-of-the-art, free lectures and poster rounds all aspects of non-small cell lung cancer will be discussed – from the molecular level to diagnosis, to treatment and survivorship. Quality of life as well as surgical techniques and multimodal strategies are being considered.

An introductory lecture will remind of the old tradition of lung cancer surgery in Central Europe, also addressing the field of ethics and innovations. A workshop will introduce the participants to the modern field of laser parenchymal surgery. The current state of multicenter studies, their co-ordination in Central Europe and the ambitious aim of research networking will be discussed. A special lecture will bring insight into the role of stem cells in carcinogenesis. Round-table discussants will talk about the topical issue of minimum procedure volumes and the planning of thoracic surgical and oncological units.

This congress emphasizes the necessity of interdisciplinary co-operation of all specialties involved in NSCLC – radiology, pathology, pneumology, oncology, thoracic surgery, radiotherapy and nuclear medicine. It is supported by 32 national and international societies and institutions. Over 150 abstracts from 17 nations cover a wide range of oncological issues; 41 trade exhibitors will inform surgeons, oncologists and pneumologists about new technologies and products. We value your experience and are looking forward to your contributions. Of course, you should also enjoy the beautiful scenery of the Salzkammergut.





Lung cancer is the leading malignant disease worldwide. Its incidence will rise within the next 50 years. Thus a Pan-European coordination of scientific studies is of utmost importance. In some European countries the problems associated with this significant increase in lung cancer are not even recognized by the national authorities, and there are not enough specialists to serve in this field of medicine.

The COST program is of special interest to a multidisciplinary community such as pneumologists, radiologists, pathologists, oncologists, and researchers involved in the diagnosis, treatment and research of lung cancer. COST offers the possibility of organizing Pan-European collaboration, of exchanging co-workers for training purposes and of increasing people's knowledge in the field of lung cancer.

This special session aims at assembling clinicians and basic researchers from different central European countries, who are interested in working for a COST proposal.

Professor Mihail L. Pascu, from the COST office in Brussels will give an introductory lecture on the COST program, and afterwards there will be ample opportunity for discussion and for preparing a proposal for a study initiative.
